Re: Request for Prescribing and Monitoring of Inclisiran for [Patient details]

We are writing in response to your request for our practice to undertake the prescribing, monitoring, and recall arrangements for this patient on Inclisiran. After careful consideration, we are writing to inform you that we are unable to accept this request for the following reasons:

Commissioning and Contractual Limitations: GPs are not commissioned to deliver Inclisiran, and it is not part of GPs' core General Medical Services (GMS) contract. The core contract is a national one and cannot be overridden by local suggestions from the Medicines Optimisation Group.

Lack of Locally Enhanced Service (LES): There is no Locally Enhanced Service (LES) offered to us to undertake this kind of work. We are aware that some other areas have a LES in place for this.

Unfunded Work: The prescribing and monitoring of Inclisiran has not been commissioned as a funded service for our practice. As such, taking on this responsibility would detract from our ability to provide core contracted services to our patients.

Workload Pressures: General practice is currently under significant pressure, and accepting additional unfunded work would jeopardise our core duty of care to our patients.

Professional Guidance: We have reviewed the joint [BMA and RCGP position statement](#) and share the same concerns.

We kindly request that you arrange for the prescribing and monitoring of Inclisiran to be managed through the appropriate specialist services.

We have sent a copy of this letter to [patient] to ensure that they are informed that this work is not the responsibility of our practice and would be grateful if you could contact them directly to provide the necessary service.
